Thank You for a lovely day, lovely big rings, although the entries are getting smaller I feel very lucky that I had some real quality bitches to go over and had to nit pick in a few of the classes.

Minor Puppy Bitch.

1st Moorey's Wongaburra Just Honey Bunch. Pale Gold, very exuberant and a real handful, but lovely to see her enjoying herself, good depth of chest, good topline nice fallaway but sadly lacking ringed tail, good feet, pretty head showing some chiseling, movement erratic! But saw enough to give her the class.

2nd Dishington's Wongaburra Mademoiselle. Slightly heavier in head, nice front assembly, good depth of chest, very hard to access movement.

3rd Robjant's Wongaburra Our Libby Lou

Puppy Bitch.

1st Moorey's Wongaburra Just Honey Bunch

2nd Robjant's Wongaburra Our Libby Lou Black, another from the same litter as one, good depth of chest, but shorter in ribbing than her sisters and was not co-operating at all.

Junior Bitch

1st Busby's Tulak Follow That Dream To Wilbus. So so much to like, classic outline, beautiful head with lovely eye, strong neck into well placed shoulders, good depth of chest, good topline, fallaway lovely rear angulation, good movement, nothing overdone, lovely.

2nd Pascoe's & Arris' Sarakman Signature. Pale Gold bitch, another with a lot to like, preferred her size to one but preferred 1's front assembly. Moved out well and a real showgirl.

Yearling Bitch.

1st Gill & Marshall's Miamarna Look To Your Dreams. Brindle girl, beautifully constructed lovely head with good under jaw, good reach of neck, good shoulder and upper arm placement, good topline held on the move, good fallaway and rear angulation, sadly she was a little underweight on the day but I empathise.

2nd Gosling's Ayoubkhan Fleur D'amour. Nice blue bitch, slightly shorter in body than

1, Nice width throughout and very well muscled, excellent condition.

Veteran Bitch.

1st Gosling's Kabella Love Is Blue JW. Blue Bitch, good length rib cage and strong loin, excellent condition, well muscled. Moved well.

Novice Bitch.

1st Busby's Tulak Follow That Dream To Wilbus.

2nd Robjant's Kabella Shimmering Moon. Pretty bitch with nice head, unfortunately she was not at all together. She needs some serious exercise to muscle up and her movement might come together.

Graduate Bitch.

What a hard class!

1st Evan's, Hiller & Carr's Gilari Devil In Disguise with Numa Boswood.. Red Bitch, pretty girl with lovely eye shape, good under jaw and a very arrogant expression! Lovely topline and good length off fallaway, good front construction, presented to perfection, moved well in this class but threw it away in the challenge.

2nd Evan's, Lee & Odell's Sukeshi Habayib.. What a beauty, lovely head and eye correctly constructed throughout, another girl with a classic outline, sadly she didn't want to co-operate on this occasion and didn't move like I know she can.

3rd Mugford's Finik Tulla

Post Graduate Bitch

1st Gosling & Felice's Ayoubkan Flue De Tiare.. Blue girl, a nice girl with good bone, nice width throughout, lovely eye giving a good expression, good depth of chest, prominent pin bones, lovely rear angulation, lovely big feet, well muscled.

2nd Cook's Mhusud Aleyah At Tedandi. Gold, heavier Build, covers ground when standing, a little erratic today but moved well when she got her act together.

3rd Care's Belamba Gold Plated.

Limit Bitch

What a lovely class, 1, 2 & 3 could change places on another day!

1st Wignall & William's Sitana Patiala of Syrdarya. Everything just flows from nose to tail on this bitch. Lovely proportioned head with lovely eye, good reach of neck into excellent shoulder and upper arm good depth and width to chest. Well ribbed and strong

loin, good length of first and second thigh. Moves well with equal reach and drive, a little reticent at times though. Nothing flashy or showy, just classy. R.B.B

2nd Green, Powell & Hitch's Zendushka's Whisky Galore JW. Another beautiful bitch, with fantastic construction. Lovely head with arrogant expression, good topline which she kept on the move, unfortunately she wouldn't use her tail, still only a young girl and I look forward to seeing her as she matures.

3rd Austin, Borash & North's Sarakhan Swansong.

Open Bitch.

Three Stunning Bitches.

1st Ryall's Metewand Wiscasset.. Well this girl just gets better as she gets older! Like so many in our breed, excellent condition, with lovely front and rear construction, lovely topline and fallaway, a real powerhouse on the move but without losing her elegance and a showgirl without losing her arrogance. Her movement won her the class. B.B & B.I.S

2nd Floyd's Hubshe Uzume. Another one of my favourites, but a little overweight which took its toll on her movement. Classic head with beautiful eye and expression, well boned with excellent construction fore and aft. A pleasure to go over, moved well covering plenty of ground but just not with the exuberance of 1.

3rd Moorey's Gezencol Whoopsie Daisy.

Special Racing Bitch

1st Mugford's Finix Tulla A little overweight, but moved well in this class, nicely constructed with plenty of substance and bone. Nice outline.

2nd Small's Metewand Mamabula. Lovely pretty little bitch, nice outline good shoulder and upperarm length and placement, strong topline, well ribbed unfortunately was throwing her feet on the move.
